August 6th Meeting – Central American Cichlids Presented by Rusty Wessel

Rusty Wessel of Louisville, Kentucky maintains 8000 gallons of freshwater aquariums in a specifically constructed, state of the art fish house. His 90+ aquariums predominantly contain cichlids and livebearers, which he successfully raise and breeds. Rusty's specialty is Central American fishes.

He has taken his hobby to a point where he has successfully collected fish from the countries of Africa, Belize, Costa Rica, Cuba, Guatemala, Honduras, Panama, and Mexico, making well over 50 trips since 1983. Considered by many to be a consummate collector, he has introduced many new species of fish to the aquarium hobby. If it lives in the water, chances are that Rusty has either caught it or been bit or stung by it.

Dr. Robert Rush Miller, emeritus professor of the University of Michigan discovered a beautiful, elusive cichlid during one of his expeditions to Honduras. He named it *Theraps wesseli*, in honor of Rusty, in the June 1996 edition of Tropical Fish Hobbyist.

On a local level in the organized hobby, Rusty is currently Treasuer for the Louisville Tropical Fish Fanciers in Kentucky. At the national level, Rusty has lectured and judged numerous fish shows throughout the United States, including the annual Florida Tropical Fish Farmers show and several American Cichlid Association conventions. He currently serves as Convention Liaison and as Back Issues Salesperson for the American Cichlid Association; he is also a participant in the ACA/Marineland Speaker's Program. ACA Board of Trustees (1990) and ACA Past Convention Chair (1992). In addition to these duties, he is an active solicitor for the ACA's "Guy Jordan Endowment Fund", which grants endowments for cichlid research. In 1997, Rusty was awarded Fellowship in the American Cichlid Association, its highest honor.

Rusty is a prolific author and photographer. His writings or photographs have appeared in a wide variety of specialty publications, such as Aquarium Fish Magazine, Aquarist and Pondkeeper, Buntbarsche Bulletin, Cichlid News, Ad Konings' Cichlid Yearbooks, Freshwater and Marine Aquarium, and Tropical Fish Hobbyist.

Rusty's presence as speaker for our August meeting is courtesy of the ACA/Marineland Speaker's Program, which has subsidized a large portion of his airfare from Kentucky.




Summary of Meeting Last Month –
